An appeals process for disputed alcohol infractions will be held monthly by the J-Board.</p>			<p>POINT REDUCTION PROGRAM - a single point value will be removed from an individual's record when no violations occur for two successive semesters (while on campus, not studying elsewhere); or, by making an alcohol-related, public presentation with SHOC; or, by completing 10 hours of non-mandated campus/community service. It is not possible to reduce more than one point per semester or more than three points during one's academic career.</p>					
<p>Individual alcohol offenses are CUMULATIVE during one's enrollment and apply to incidents occurring on and off campus.</p>			<p>MULTIPLE INFRACTIONS - For one and two point infractions, the highest point value is assessed and no additional point values are assigned in a multiple infractions case. For three point infractions and above, the highest point value will be assessed and an additional one or two points and no more.</p>					
<p>Definitions: BAC - Blood Alcohol Count, DP - Disciplinary Probation, PDP - Permanent Disciplinary Probation, SHOC - Student Health on Campus</p>			<p>ALCOHOL TREATMENT - Colby's alcohol and substance abuse counselor will use his or her professional discretion to determine if and when outside referral/treatment is necessary, independent of the number of points accumulated.</p>					
<p>Emergency Room treatment for alcohol intoxication will be handled as a medical issue with assessment made by College medical staff. Parents are notified.</p>			<p>Alcohol violations noted by authorities which occur off campus will draw points per the Alcohol Point Infraction System.</p>
